



The Osmo Flooring Care and Maintenance range

For everyday cleaning, a broom or vacuum cleaner is all you need. To remove stains, the floor can also be mopped. If done regularly, adding Osmo Wash and Care to the water will help to clean and maintain your floor.

Stubborn stains can easily be removed with Osmo Liquid Wax Cleaner. Just apply to the floor with a cloth or Osmo Polishing Pad (use Scotch Brit on oak floors).

If the floor starts to look a bit lifeless after a while, revitalise it with Osmo Liquid Wax Cleaner. This can also be applied to specific areas (such as around the doors or on patches that have become worn), there is no need to treat the whole floor. Apply Osmo Liquid Wax Cleaner neat but very thinly to the clean floor with a lint-free cloth and then polish.

To make it even easier for you, Osmo Liquid Wax Cleaner also comes as a spray.

For particularly defined wear marks, the floor should be given a new treatment with Osmo Polyx®-Oil.

Simply apply Osmo Polyx®-Oil thinly to the affected areas (having cleaned them) and leave to dry overnight. This can also be done to specific areas; there is no need to treat the whole floor.

If desired, when thoroughly dry, the floor can be polished with Osmo Liquid Wax Cleaner to obtain an even shine.

### Larger and well-used floors in public areas

Wooden floors in public places such as restaurants, department stores, offices, shops, conference halls, schools etc. may be used by a lot of people.

In order to ensure that they remain looking good, as well as considering the type of wood to use and which areas will be most used, the following care and maintenance tips should be observed. Larger areas can easily be maintained mechanically.

If desired, the floor can be swept or mopped daily.

Add Osmo Wash and Care to the water to avoid calcium carbonate residues. Immediately wipe the floor dry.

Stubborn stains can easily be removed with Osmo Liquid Wax Cleaner (also available as a spray).

Regularly treat the clean and dry floor with Osmo Liquid Wax Cleaner (especially the most used areas).

Apply thinly from the can and spread using an electric brushing machine with a thick brush or a single disc brushing machine with beige pads.

Polish when dry (brushing machine with a fine brush or single disc brushing machine with a white pad).

The areas used most can also be renovated individually without needing to treat the whole floor. For this, just apply Osmo Polyx®-Oil thinly to the clean and dry floor; remember to go right to the edges, leave to dry and polish if desired.
